PH.D. EARLY RESEARCH REQUIREMENT

Ph.D. students shall conduct and present an educational research study early in their graduate programs. In the first year of doctoral study, Ph.D. students, in consultation with their advisors, shall form an Early Research Committee consisting of the advisor and two other faculty members. Before the formation of the preliminary oral examination committee, the student should formally present to his or her Early Research Committee a written and oral report on the early research project. All three members of the committee must approve the work as satisfying the early research requirement for the Ph.D.
