Dr. Sam Museus is an Associate Professor of Higher Education in the Morgridge College of Education at the University of Denver. He has produced over 130 publications and national conference presentations focused on understanding the racial, cultural, and structural factors that affect the experiences and outcomes of diverse populations in K-12 and higher education. His books include *Conducting Research on Asian Americans in Higher Education* (2009), *Creating Campus Cultures: Fostering Success among Racially Diverse Student Populations* (with Uma M. Jayakumar, 2012), and *Asian American Students in Higher Education* (2013). Dr. Museus is on the editorial boards of the *Journal of College Student Development* and the *Journal of Higher Education*. In 2014, he was the recipient of the George D. Kuh National Association of Student Personnel Administrators Outstanding Contribution to Research Award and the American Educational Research Association Multicultural and Multiethnic Education Dr. Carlos J. Vallejo Memorial Award for Exemplary Scholarship.
