Take the CTA subway Blue Line to Clinton Station. Walk two blocks to Union Station for Amtrak or Greyhound service to Champaign's Bus Terminal.

### Or, from Midway:

Take the CTA elevated Orange Line to Quincy Station. Walk about three blocks to Union Station for Amtrak or Greyhound service to Champaign's Bus Terminal.

## Parking on Campus

As at most large universities, daytime parking on the Urbana-Champaign campus can be difficult, and it may be more convenient to walk to some destinations. Between 6 a.m. and 5 p.m., visitors may park in metered spaces along streets and in metered spaces in designated University parking lots and facilities. Metered spaces are \$0.75 an hour. All other campus lots are reserved for permit holders only, and your car may be towed if you park in prohibited spaces.

In addition to campus facilities, a municipal lot is located on Green Street between Fifth and Sixth Streets. After 5 p.m. and on weekends and holidays, university lots are open to visitors, subject to posted restrictions.

If you plan to be on campus for several days contact the Division of Campus Parking and Transportation, 1110 W. Springfield, Urbana, 333-3530, and they will provide information and help assist you with parking arrangements. Visitors can purchase a Parking Permit by using their credit card as payment and have their Parking Permit mailed to them or pick up their Parking

permit at the Parking Department.
