

CERTIFICATE OF ADVANCED STUDY (CAS) DEGREE PROGRAM PLAN

All students in the Certificate of Advanced Study program must meet the minimum degree requirements: 1) The entire program must be planned in advance and must be preceded by at least two years of acceptable professional work experience. 2) Thirty-two or more hours in approved coursework must be taken beyond the master's degree. 3) Sixteen of these 32 hours must be taken at the 500-level. 4) Students who have completed a Master's degree at another institution other than the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign must also fulfill the foundations course requirements. Individual departments in the College of Education may require additional courses to complete the degree program. A copy of the student's program, signed by the adviser, must be filed in the department during the first semester of summer session registration.
